**Isaiah 53:6-12 GNT**

Reader

One: All of us were like sheep that were lost, each of us going his way. But the Lord made the punishment fall on him, (our Lord Jesus)

**All: the punishment all of us deserved.**

One: "He was treated harshly, but endured it humbly;

**All: he never said a word.**

One: Like a lamb about to be slaughtered, like a sheep about to be sheared,

**All: he never said a word.**

One: He was arrested and sentenced and led off to die, and no one cared about his fate.

**All: He was put to death for the sins of our people.**

One: He was placed in a grave with those who are evil, he was buried with the rich,

**All: even though he had never committed a crime or ever told a lie."**

One: The Lord says, "It was my will that he should suffer,

**All: his death was a sacrifice to bring forgiveness.**

One: And so he will see his descendants; he will live a long life, and through him my purpose will succeed. After a life of suffering, he will again have joy,

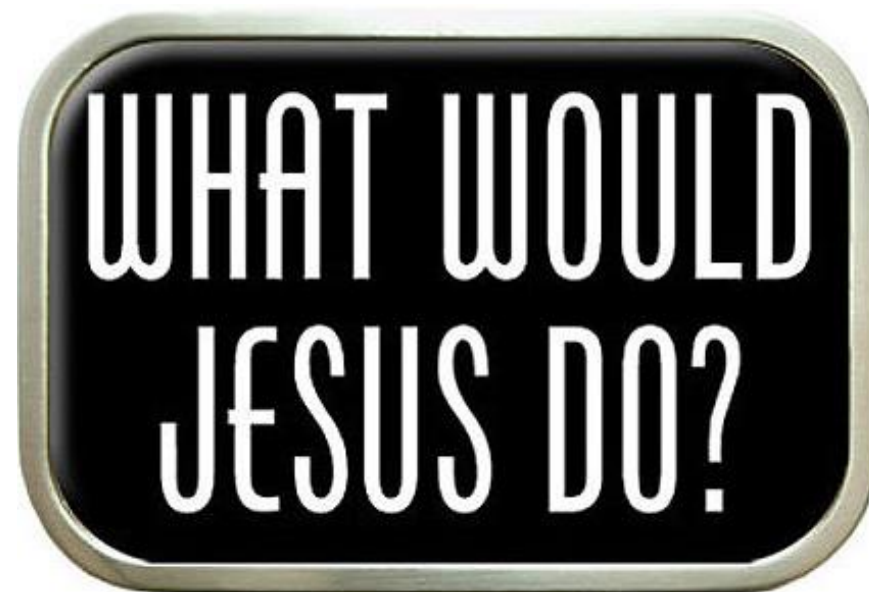
